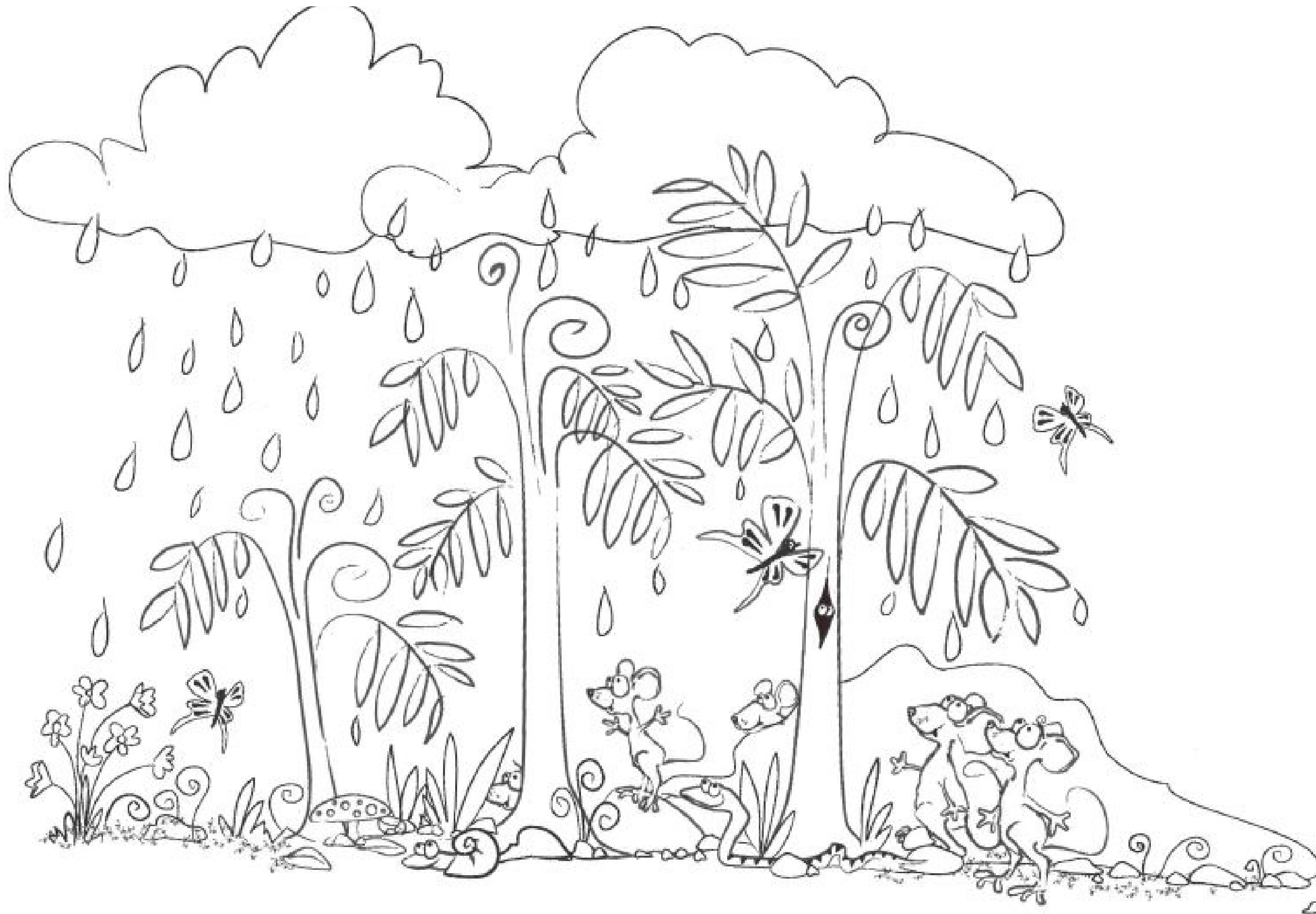


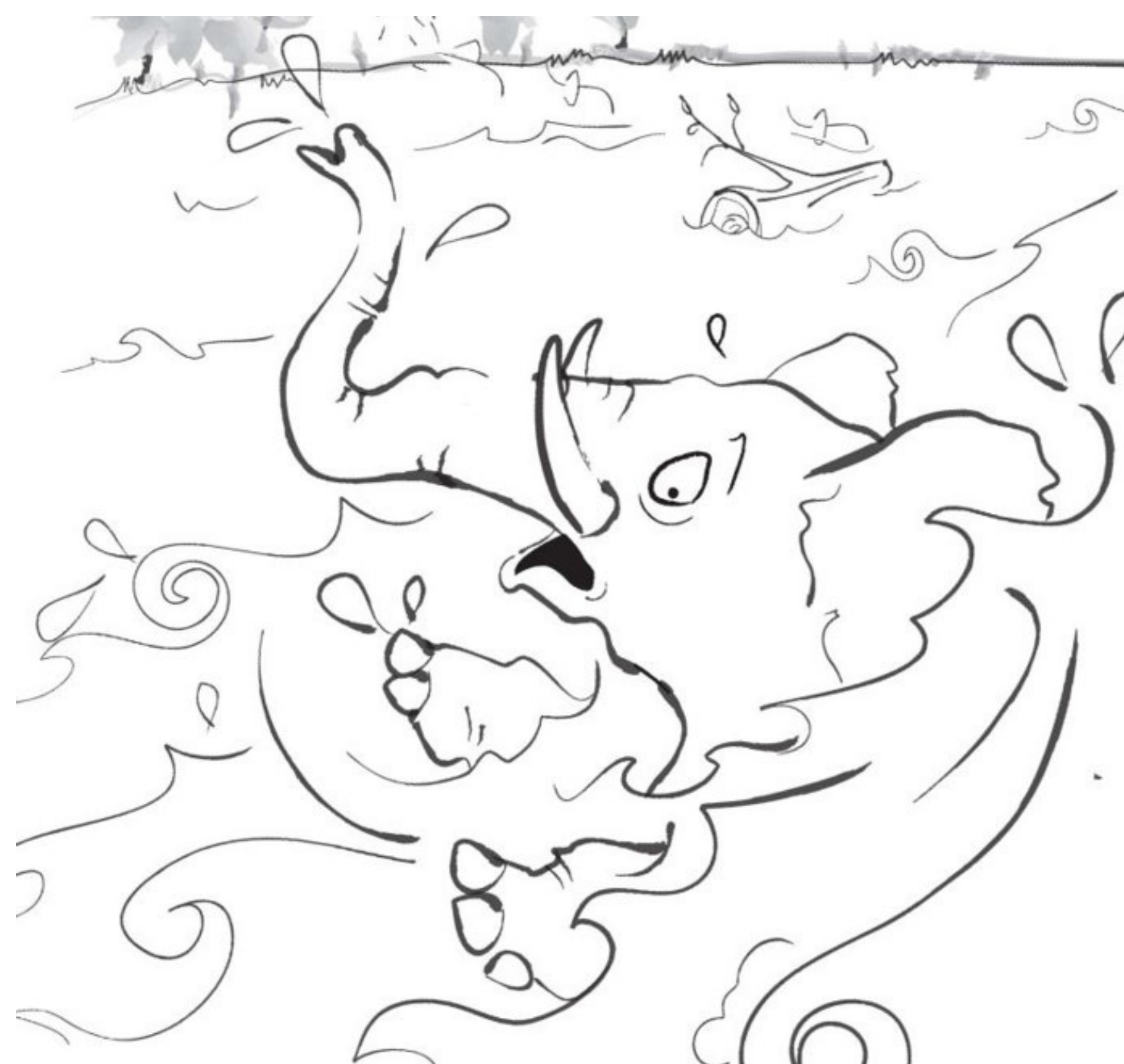


Frankl Explains:

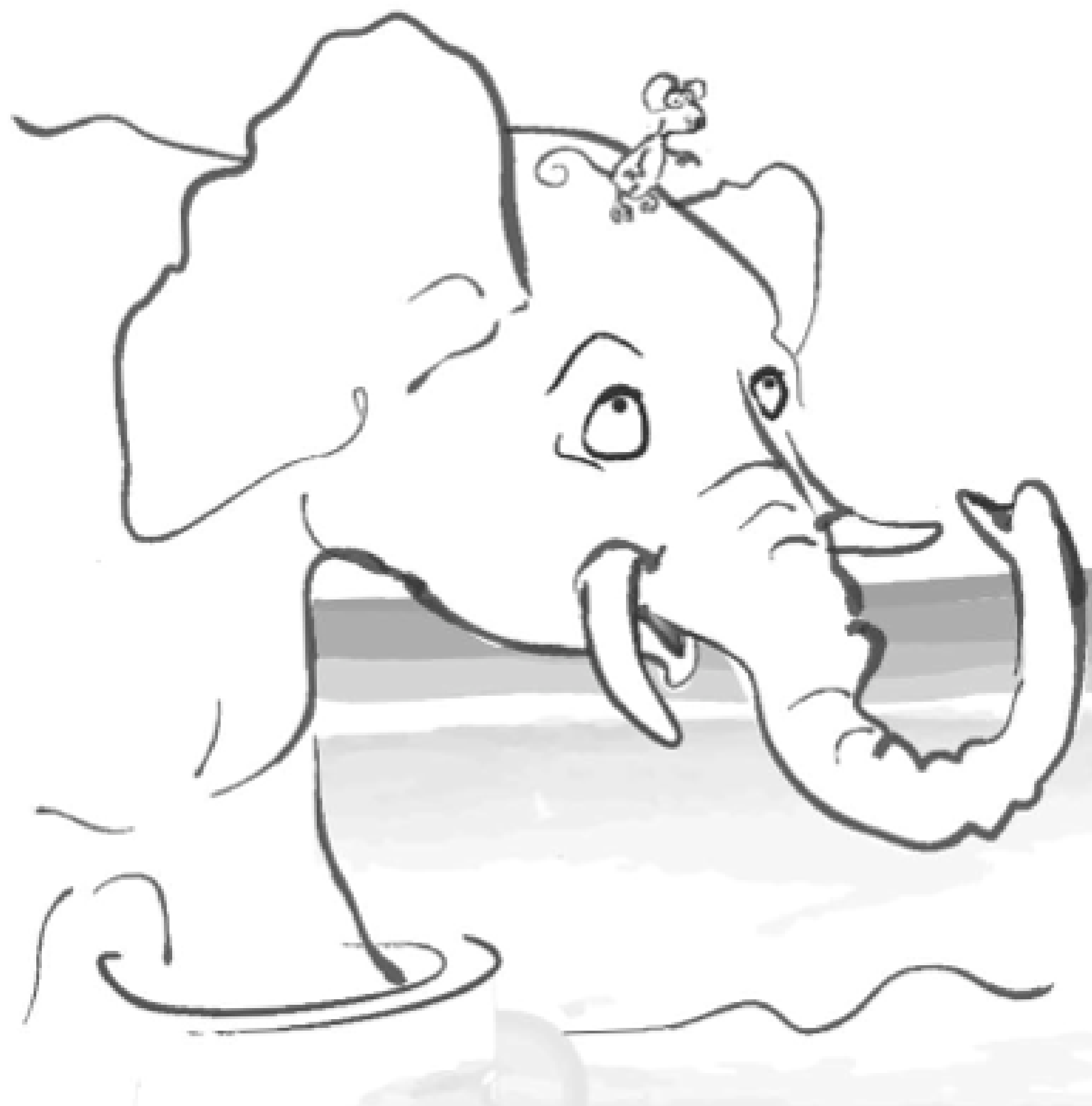

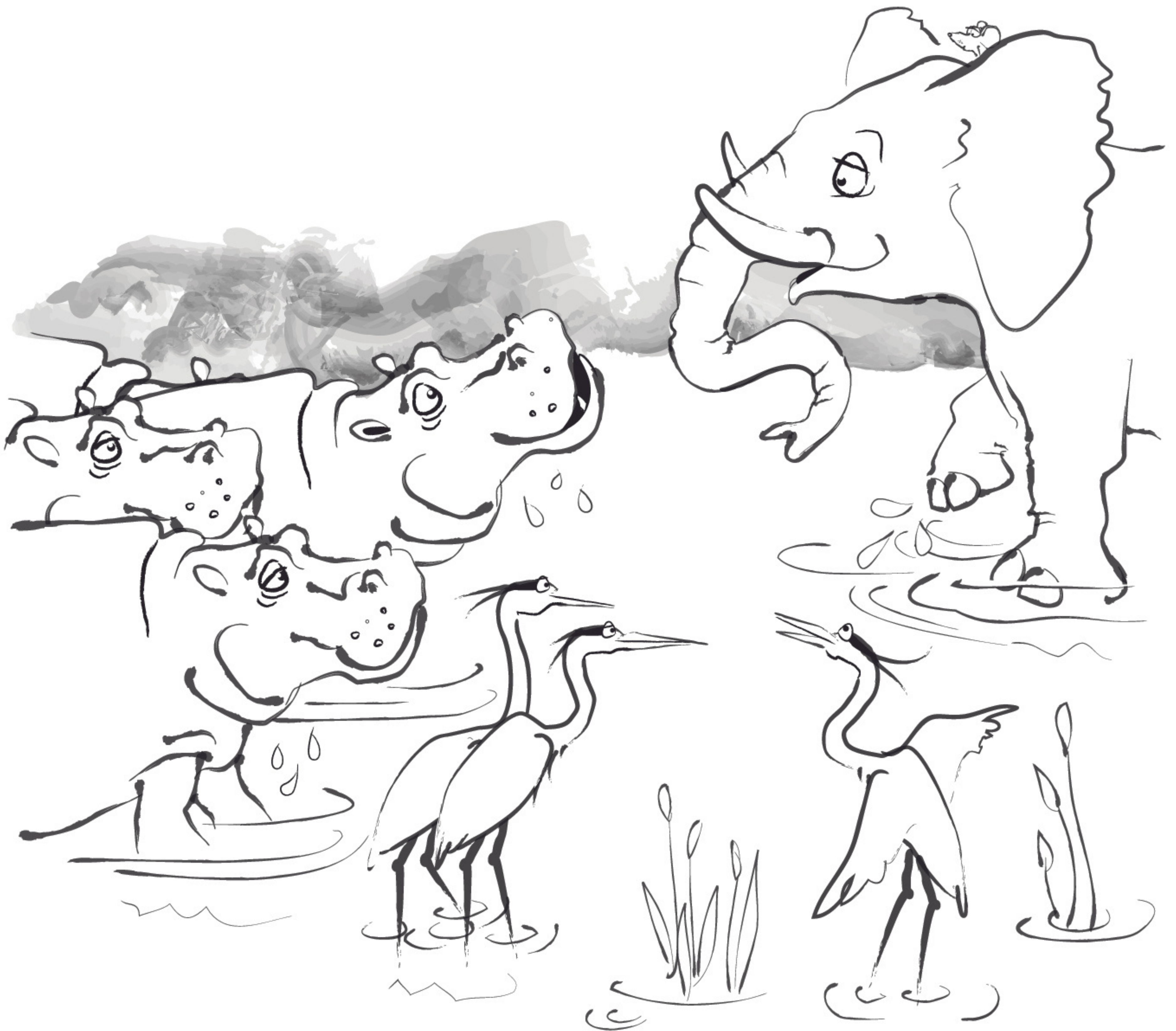

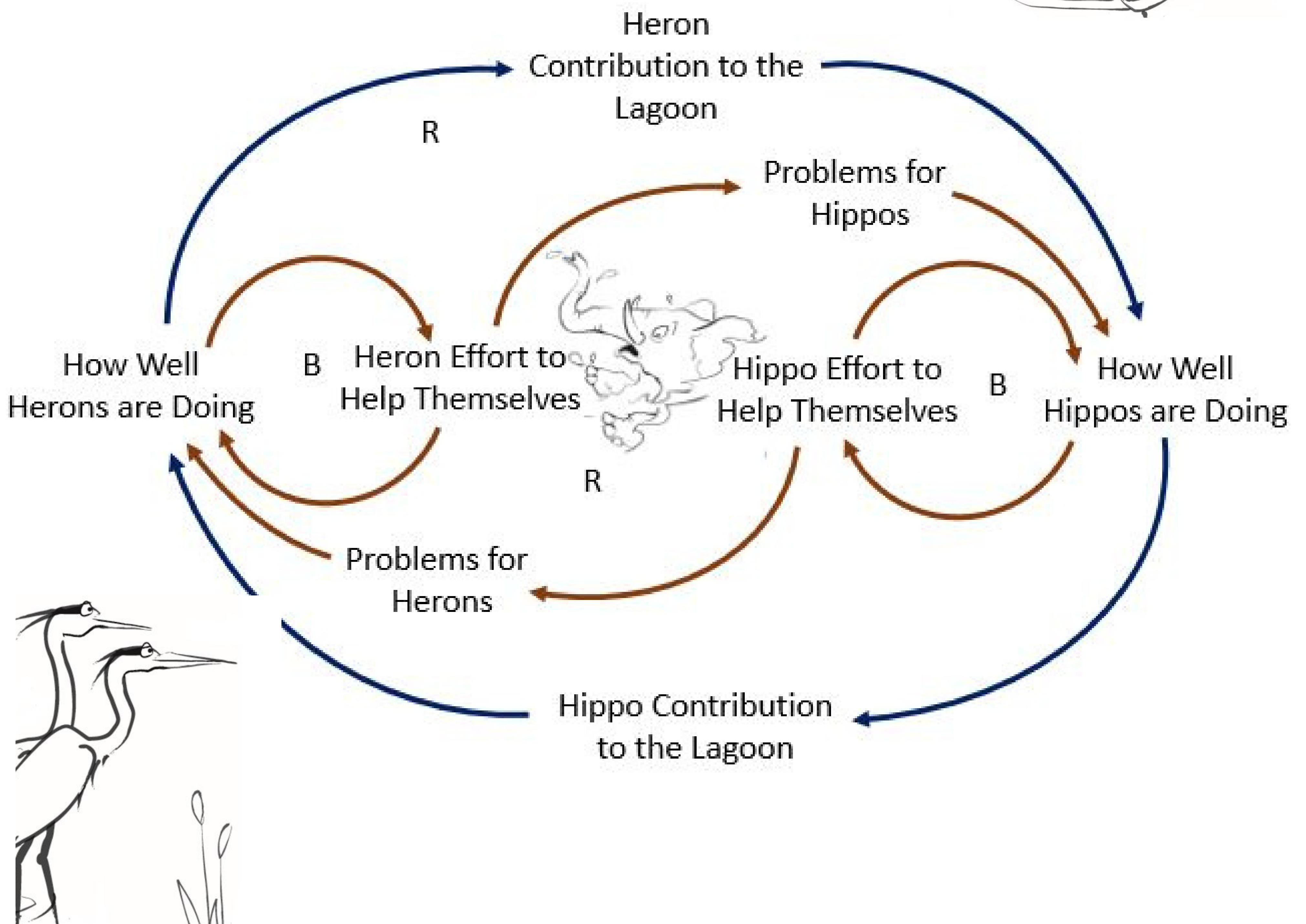

Frankl Explains:

Accidental adversaries...

Things work best when everyone contributes to the whole system working well (the outer blue loop).



But when we focus just on ourselves, we can accidentally become each other's adversaries. When the inner brown loop is strongest, problems are created for everyone.
